COURSE DESCRIPTION:

In this class you will learn how to quilt curling feathers, a hook feather ideal for edge to edge patterns and a braided feather. Fill patterns include pebbles, 2 different cushion designs, a fire design, paisleys and spirals. There is also a leaf and loop design ideal for freehand edge to edge quilting, a central motif and micro quilting. All designs are quilted free-motion and you will learn to draw and quilt these designs
