Two different cutting measurements will be given, depending on the size the student wants to make the article. A discussion, tips and short notes will be given about Modern Quilting.

Extension cord and adaptor
Cutting board and rotary cutter
Quilter's ruler

Pre-cut strips of 100% cotton fabric (instructions will be given after Registration)

Pre-drawn grid on foundation fabric depending on desired size of article (calico, sheeting or strong Vilene)

Matching thread
