DETAILED COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Learn the technique of foundation paper piecing which makes accurate stars and fine points.

Student Requirements:

Two metres background/neutral fabric

A variety of assorted fabrics for the sun rays in four different colours or tones – adding up to half a metre of each colour. This will make a quilt 50" X 65".

For a bigger quilt you will need 2.5 metres of background fabric and 75cm of the four different colours.

Sewing machine in good working order, cleaned and oiled with a new machine needle and a spare machine needle.

Extension cord and adaptor.

Neutral sewing thread and bobbins wound with this thread.

Foundation papers will be supplied.

Basic sewing supplies.
