#### DETAILED COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Three fat quarters and three techniques – raw-edge overlapping appliqué, snippets technique for centre, novelty way of textured edging. Choose your three colours to match your decor. Suitable for a cushion, centre panel etc. Project can be completed in the class. Pattern will be provided.

#### Student Requirements:

3 fat quarters (flower, background, snippet center and edge)

Batting - size as fat quarter

Material for backing - size as fat quarter

50x50cm appliqué paper ironed on material for flower

Thread for detail stitching

Thread for centre snippet stitching

Sewing machine in good working order

Extension cord and adaptor

Basic sewing supplies
