All your scrappy fabrics - 1½" and bigger
Sewing machine in good working order
Extension cord and adaptor
Machine needles (Universal 80)
Machine thread (grey or beige)
Roll of till tape (3" wide)
1 x A4 blank sheet of paper
Pencil and eraser
Rotary cutter, cutting mat and quilter's ruler
