A fat quarter of plain, good quality, light-coloured fabric, 100% cotton or linen Marking tool – a good quality HB pencil and sharpener or chalk pencil in a colour that will show up on your chosen fabric Stranded embroidery floss in various colours Embroidery needles – a pack of Size 5/10, however, a Size 8 is a good all rounder Small, sharp scissors Basic sewing supplies Small embroidery hoop (optional)
