DETAILED COURSE DESCRIPTION:

An exercise in trellis work and filler stitches. Come to Tracy's class to learn the basics of trellis work which will set you on a creative journey into designing your own trellis combinations. Students will also learn how to combine basic traditional embroidery stitches in unusual ways.

Student Requirements:

A fat quarter of plain, good quality, light-coloured fabric, 100% cotton or linen Small embroidery hoop about 5" – 6" in diameter Stranded embroidery floss in various colours

Perlé thread No 8 and /or No 12 in various colours plus a No 22 Chepille needle (or No 12 in various colours)

Perlé thread No 8 and /or No 12 in various colours, plus a No 22 Chenille needle (optional) Small, sharp scissors

Embroidery needles —a pack of Size 5/10, however, a Size 8 is a good all-rounder Marking tool, preferably a good quality HB pencil, good quality eraser and sharpener or chalk pencil in a colour that will show up on your chosen fabric Basic sewing supplies
