DETAILED COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Learn to do a quilter's knot and blanket stitch around the heart. Once the batting is secured you will learn to quilt around the heart to create this quilted greeting card.

Cost of Kit: R100

Detailed Contents of kit:

1 x Aperture greeting card with coloured envelope.

1 x piece of white fabric with precision cut Shweshwe heart already fused.

1 x precut batting.

Needle & thread to make the card.
