

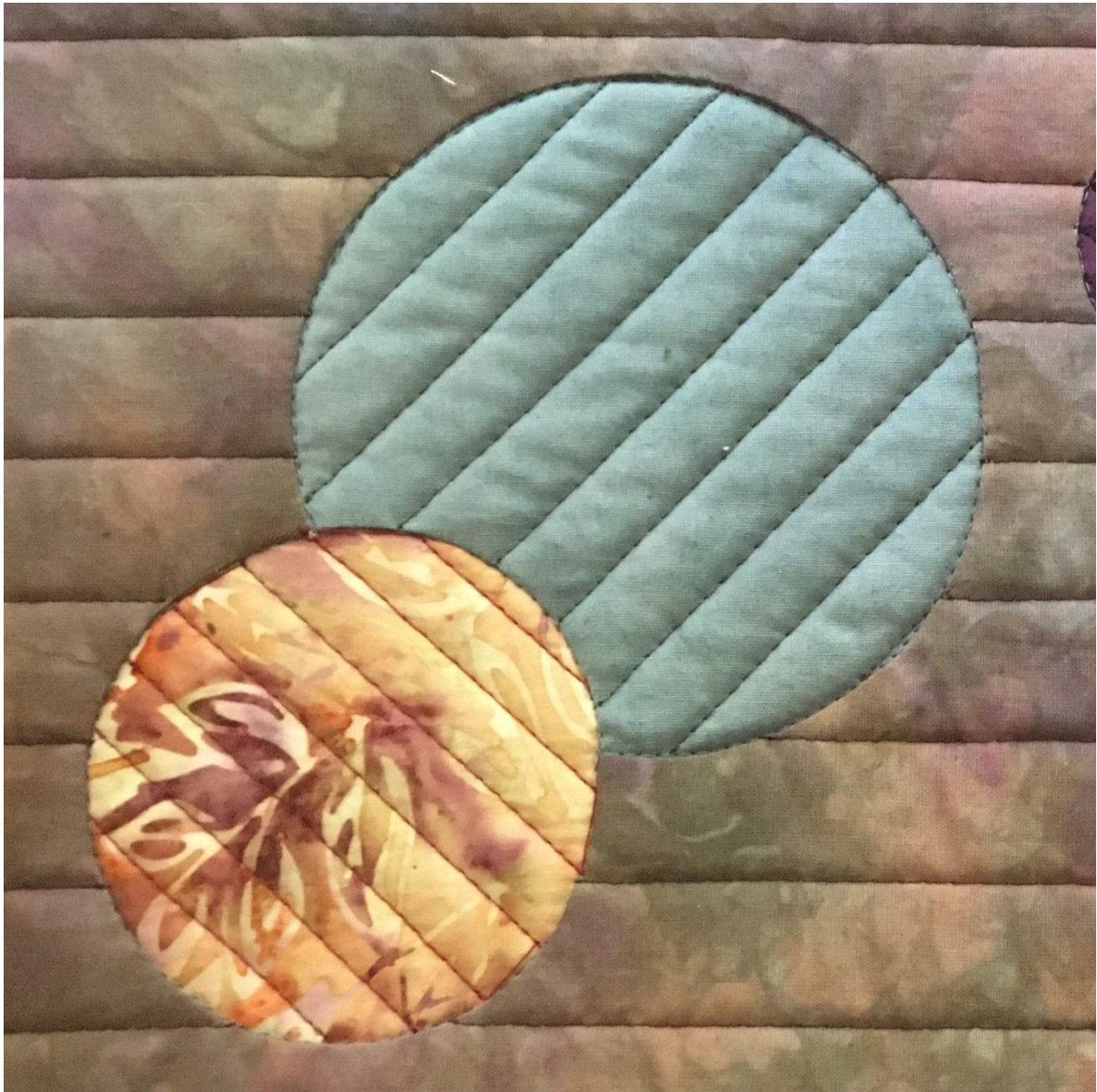

DETAILED COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Students will learn the very impressive technique of inserting a circle into a piece of fabric with a neatly stitched seam – clean, neat and flat. Single and overlapping circles will be taught. Note: this is NOT an appliqué method.
